DAY 1 KUALA LUMPUR > BEIJING

> Assemble at airport for flight to **Beijing**, capital of China.

DAY 2 BEIJING HOHHOT

[MOB]

- After lunch, take the high-speed train to Hohhot, the capital of Inner Mongolia. "Hohhot" is a Mongolian word, which means "Blue City" in Chinese. It is located in Tumochuan, central Inner Mongolia Autonomous Region. Hohhot is the capital of the region and serves as its political, economic, and cultural center. It is also a historically and culturally significant city in northern China.
- > After dinner, enjoy an overnight stay in Hohhot.

DAY 3 HOHHOT

[B/L/D]

- After breakfast, head to the Xilamuren Grassland. Upon arrival, experience the Mongolian welcoming ceremony and partake in the tradition of drinking XiamaJiu, a Mongolian custom symbolizing the hospitality of the grassland people. Then, watch exciting grassland entertainment while enjoying the vast and breathtaking scenery of the open grasslands. Next, visit the joyful pasture on the grassland, where you can experience local culture and customs by dressing in traditional Mongolian robes for photos, making milk tea, learning Mongolian, writing in Mongolian script, and making treats like candied hawthorn
- Continue your tour at Monishan Intangible Cultural Heritage Town, a place where natural beauty meets rich cultural heritage. It is an important stop along the "Tea Road" Intangible Cultural Heritage journey and the first large open-air museum in Inner Mongolia themed around intangible cultural heritage.
- Check in at the popular Kuanxiangzhi Food Street in Hohhot, a vibrant urban district primarily inhabited by the Hui ethnic group. The area is known for its strong Islamic cultural atmosphere and distinct ethnic charm.
- After dinner, return to hotel for rest.

DAY 4 HOHHOT [B/L/D]

- In the early morning, head to the **Wulanhada Volcano** in Ulanqab City, a geopark that combines volcanic clusters, lava plateaus, hot springs, and more. The volcano group here features unique and well-preserved geological formations. Volcanic cones, lava flows, and dammed lakes together form the main landscape of the Wulanhada Volcano Cluster. It's one of the few places in the world where volcanic eruption remnants, grassland scenery, and rich ecological resources create a breathtaking natural panorama—definitely worth exploring for its fascinating beauty
- Next, visit the Baorhan Buddha Pagoda—the world's first Buddha pagoda—a Buddhist structure with distinct local characteristics. This centuries-old Han Chinese Buddhist temple is revered for its solemnity and spiritual aura, attracting numerous worshippers who kneel and bow here in search of blessings.
- Continue your tour at Tongshun Street, a food street that blends the nostalgic flavors of old Hohhot with traditional-style architecture. The alley is filled with a wide variety of local delicacies, offering a perfect opportunity to taste authentic regional snacks.
- > After dinner, return to hotel for rest.

DAY 5 HOHHOT A BAOTOU DALAD BANNER [B/L/D]

- After breakfast, head to Baotou to visit Northern Weapon City, the first military-themed tourist attraction in North China. This unique park is built on principles of green ecology, with a focus on showcasing military industry culture while offering leisure and entertainment experiences.
- Then, take part in a traditional paper-cutting activity, an intangible cultural heritage that allows you to appreciate the intricate charm of this folk art and gain insight into the richness of Chinese craft traditions.
- > Enjoy free time at **Baotou Golden Street**, the city's vibrant commercial district, and perfect for shopping, sightseeing, or simply soaking in the local vibe.
- > After dinner, check into the hotel for overnight stay in Dalad Banner.

DAY 6 DALAD BANNER A XIANGSHAWAN ORDOS

After breakfast, depart for Xiangshawan, a desert resort destination [round-trip cableway ride included]. This vast desert features rolling sand dunes, picturesque crescent-shaped dune chains, rare ridge sands, and honeycomb-like sand formations. Known as the "King of Singing Sands," Xiangshawan is a natural wonder. It is home to the world's first desert cableway, China's largest camel herd, and a top-tier ethnic art troupe. The mysterious phenomenon of the singing sands has puzzled people for centuries, giving rise to many beautiful legends.

- Next, head to the Genghis Khan's Mausoleum in Ordos. This is a cenotaph and symbolic memorial of Genghis Khan, the first Great Khan of the Mongol Empire. As an imperial tomb of great historical significance, it stands out with its stunning grassland surroundings, mysterious cultural landscapes, and deep ethnic heritage, showcasing the grandeur of a prairie emperor's resting place. Here, there is special arrangement for Scared Lamp blessing and Praise ceremony.
- > After dinner, check into the hotel for the overnight stay in Ordos.

DAY 7 ORDOS HOHHOT

[B/L/D]

- After breakfast, take a bus to visit the Inner Mongolia Museum [closed on Mondays]. This museum combines strong modern elements, regional characteristics, and ethnic features. It serves as an "encyclopedia" of Northern China's history and is also a symbol of the region's economic and social development.
- In the afternoon, head to Genghis Khan Square to take photos with the statue of the legendary hero Genghis Khan, experiencing his indomitable spirit.
- Then, visit the General Government Office Museum of Inner Mongolia [closed on Mondays]. Built upon the Qing Dynasty Suiyuan General Office, this ancient architectural museum showcases the historical evolution, layout, local customs of Suiyuan City, and the urban development of Hohhot. It highlights its significant role in maintaining and consolidating China's northern border while promoting ethnic unity and integration.
- Overnight stay in Hohhot hotel.
- * Hohhot Huachen Lvyue Hotel or similar

DAY 8 HOHHOT [B/L/D]

- After breakfast, visit Dazhao Temple, a large Tibetan Buddhist temple in the southern part of Yuquan District, Hohhot. It belongs to the Gelug sect and has a wide influence in the Mongolian region. The temple is also known as the "Silver Buddha Temple" because it enshrines a silver Buddha statue. Its magnificent architecture, precious cultural relics, and artworks form a unique cultural heritage.
- Next, explore Saishang Old Street, a historic street featuring Ming and Qing dynasty architectural styles.
- Visit the Zhaojun Museum in Yuquan District, Hohhot [closed on Mondays]. The museum consists of the Xiongnu Culture Museum, Zhaojun Tomb, Heqin Palace, and the Zhaojun Memorial Hall. Here, you can learn about the historical story of Zhaojun's journey to the frontier and the life of Wang Zhaojun, one of the Four Great Beauties of ancient China.
- After dinner, return to the hotel for another night stay.
- * Hohhot Huachen Lvyue Hotel or similar

DAY 9 HOHHOT — BEIJING

[B/D]

- After breakfast, head to the train station for high-speed train back to Beijing.
- Visit Qianmen Street, where you can see the Zhengyang Gate Arrow Tower, Beijing Fang, the flagship store of Starbucks, and Page One bookstore.
- Enjoy dinner and check into the hotel for overnight stay in Beijing.

DAY 10 BEIJING > KUALA LUMPUR

Passengers are deemed to have read, understood and accepted the following conditions. The organizer shall be known as "The Company" in the conditions below.

RESERVATIONS AND DEPOSIT

A deposit of RM 500 - RM 3,000.00 (subject to tour package selected) is required upon booking. The balance is to be paid in full 31 days before departure. Failure to comply with this may result in an automatic cancellation of reservation and a forfeiture of deposit. Deposits are applicable for the tour booked only and are not transferable.

CREDIT CARD / CHARGE CARD

An administrative fee is chargeable for payments by credit or charge card.

CANCELLATION / AMENDMENTS

- Cancellation of a confirmed booking must be made in writing to avoid misunderstanding.
- Postponement / transfer of tour will be deemed to be a cancellation and will be charged accordingly.
- Cancellations during peak, festive or holiday seasons will result in 100% forfeiture of the booking deposit.
- 4) For each amendment made after a booking has been confirmed, a fee will be charge by the respective airlines and service suppliers. An amendment does not constitute a transfer to another tour.

if the result of the rejection is made known to the Company at least 30 days prior to departures.

The Company cannot be held responsible for any expenses, reimbursement or refund of any tour fares if passenger is refused entry by any country on the tour for whatever reasons, including lack of necessary visas.

SEAT ROTATION

For the convenience of all members of the group, passengers are requested to rotate their seating arrangements on the coach during the period of the tour. Please co-operate when called upon to do so by the tour leader/guide.

TRAVEL INSURANCE

Strongly recommended with respect to such areas as trip cancellation, personal baggage, personal accident, injury and illness. Under no circumstance is The Company to be construed as a carrier under contract for safe carriage of the passenger or her/his baggage and belongings. Our staff will be pleased to assist in the enquiries of any travel insurance.

EXTENSION OF STAY / DEVIATION

Extension of stay / deviation may be permitted at the end of the tour, subject to validity and restrictions of air ticket, seat confirmation and availability of hotel prior to the commencement of tour. It is the passenger's responsibility to hold firm confirmation for their return flight. When extension of stay / deviation cannot be confirmed three weeks prior to the group's departure date, the passenger is deemed to be taking the original tour schedule.
