









# 9 DAYS 7 NIGHTS IMPRESSIVE GUIZHOU XINGYI / ANSHUN / ZHIJIN / WUJIANGZHAI / XIJIANG / LIBO / GUIYANG [CKGZ]

## DAY 1 KUALA LUMPUR > KUNMING

- Assemble at the airport for your flight to Kunming.
- Upon arrival, proceed to the hotel for check-in.

## DAY 2 KUNMING A XINGYI

[B/L/D]

[MOB]

- After breakfast, proceed to Xingyi, a country-level city administered by the Qianxinan Buyei and Miao Autonomous Prefecture, in the southwest of Guizhou Province.
- Upon arrival, proceed to visit Wanfeng Lake [boat ride included], which enjoys the reputation of 'the lake of among tens of thousands of lakes and a top choice for a beautiful landscape painting in the southwest of China'.
- Next, visit Wanfenglin Scenic Area [buggy ride included], where the majestic and grand peaks boast unique shapes and elegant formations. It is one of the largest and most representative Karst peak forests. The area also features a vast natural "Bagua Field," known as the "Earth's Eye," symbolizing the eye of the land. Wanfenglin home to unique plants, natural springs, Tiankeng the natural sinkholes, and original Bouyei ethnic villages in the surroundings, preserving their original charm.

## DAY 3 XINGYI ANSHUN

[B/L/D]

- After breakfast, visit Huangguoshu Scenic Spot [buggy + one-way escalator ride included] to explore the Huangguoshu Waterfall, the third largest in the world and the largest in Asia. It is the most spectacular waterfall in the group, uniquely featuring a naturally penetrating water curtain cave where visitors can hear, see, and touch the waterfall from inside and outside the cave.
- Next, visit the Doupotang Waterfall, located 1 kilometer upstream from the Huangguoshu Waterfall. It has the widest waterfall, top among all the waterfalls.
- Next, visit the Tianxingqiao Scenic Area, which showcases the essence of Karst landforms. Here, the stones, trees, and water form a magical combination, creating a natural bonsai-like landscape shaped by the transformation of the stone forest on water.

## DAY 4 ANSHUN 🗐 ZHIJIN

[B/L/D]

- After breakfast, visit Zhijin Cave Scenic Area, now a national geological park which is rated as the first among the "Six Most Beautiful Tourist Caves in China".
  - [Remarks] From March to April, visit Baili Rhododendron instead. The attraction is a national 5A-level tourist attraction and the largest native rhododendron forest ever identified in China. It is a grand natural garden named for its wild azeleas.
- Then, visit the historical and cultural town of Zhijin Ancient Town, and explore the central area of the ancient town and the rare architectural style of the Caishen Temple, which was built entirely without a single nail or rivet, relying solely on human labour and resembling Japan's Tenshukaku. Pass through the bustling ancient town's pedestrian street, with its old shops, reflecting the local ethnic culture and human warmth.
- ➤ In the evening, enjoy a night tour of the charming **Pingyuan Ancient Town**, and be captivated by the brilliant lights, the quaint bricks and tiles, and the dazzling modern lights which blended perfectly.

## DAY 5 ZHIJIN 🚍 WUJIANGZHAI

[B/L/D]

- Visit Wujiang Village Scenic Area [electric car ride included]. Here, the picturesque mountain and water environment and the rich folk customs of the northern Qiandongnan region make you feel as if you've traveled through time to a real Shangri-La. In the evening, you can join the local residents for a bonfire party, singing and dancing together. There are various rich performances such as Cultural Heritage of Single Bamboo Drifting Water Ballet, the Wujiang Star Music Water Show, drone light shows, and the release of sky lanterns [subject to weather conditions].

## DAY 6 WUJIANGZHAI A KALA VILLAGE XIJIANG [B/L/D]

- After breakfast, depart to Danzhai to visit the Kala Birdcage Village that has a 400-year history of bird cage weaving. The villagers are known for their cage weaving skills. Proceed to visit the Silverware Museum.
- Then, head to Xijiang to visit Xijiang Qianhu Miao Village [buggy ride included], a place that preserves the "primitive ecology" and culture of the Miao community. Visit the Miao Ethnic Museum, where you can explore and learn about the long history and development of the Miao people in China and get a glimpse of the life of a Miao family, and a chance to walk the streets and alleys of the village.
- > After that, take photos in a **Miao costume**.
- After dinner, enjoy an overnight stay in Xijiang.

## DAY 7 XIJIANG 🛱 LIBO

[B/L/D]

- After breakfast, visit the Xiaoqikong [Libo's Seven Small Arches] Scenic Area [buggy ride included]. The scenic area integrates various landscapes such as forests, caves, lakes, rocks and waters. For its exquisiteness and beauty, it enjoys the reputation of "super bonsai". Attractions to view at the scenic site include the famous Xiaoqikong Ancient Bridge, Yuanyang Lake, the beautiful 68-level Xiangshuihe Waterfall and Laya Waterfall.
- > Enjoy dinner and an overnight stay in Libo.

# DAY 8 LIBO 🖨 GUIYANG 🗢 KUNMING 🧡 K. LUMPUR [B/L/D]

- After breakfast, leave Libo for Guiyang.
- Upon arrival, visit Jiaxiu Tower, a representative landmark of Guiyang. This renowned ancient pavilion stands over 20 meters tall and has three stories with three eaves, featuring a pagoda-like wooden structure. Its architectural style is unique and distinctive, making it a one-of-a-kind creation in ancient Chinese architecture. Many visitors are eager to admire its beauty. This ancient pavilion has endured over 400 years of history, and can be said to have witnessed the development of Guiyang.
- > Then, proceed to a grocery shop for local souvenirs.
- In the afternoon, return to Kunming by high-speed train.
- After dinner, transfer to the airport for your flight to Kuala Lumpur.

Passengers are deemed to have read, understood and accepted the following conditions. The organizer shall be known as "The Company" in the conditions below.

#### RESERVATIONS AND DEPOSIT

A deposit of RM 500 - RM 3,000.00 (subject to tour package selected) is required upon booking. The balance is to be paid in full 31 days before departure. Failure to comply with this may result in an automatic cancellation of reservation and a forfeiture of deposit. Deposits are applicable for the tour booked only and are not transferable.

#### **CREDIT CARD / CHARGE CARD**

An administrative fee is chargeable for payments by credit or charge card.

#### **CANCELLATION / AMENDMENTS**

- 1) Cancellation of a confirmed booking must be made in writing to avoid misunderstanding.
- Postponement / transfer of tour will be deemed to be a cancellation and will be charged accordingly.
- Cancellations during peak, festive or holiday seasons will result in 100% forfeiture of the booking deposit.
- 4) For each amendment made after a booking has been confirmed, a fee will be charge by the respective airlines and service suppliers. An amendment does not constitute a transfer to another tour.
- Deposits paid during travel fairs are non-refundable and will be forfeited if passenger cancels tour.

Eligibility: Below 12 years (on the date of departure) Child fare is based on sharing a room with two adults. There will be an additional cost for child sharing one room with an adult.

## ACCOMMODATION

## SPECIAL REQUEST

## TRAVEL DOCUMENTS

It is the passenger's responsibility to ensure that his/her international passport has a validity of at least 6 months from the date of departure. Relevant visas and vaccinations may be required. An administrative fee of RM50.00 per person will be levied for any cancellation due to non-approval of visas.

The Company will, wherever possible, assist you to obtain the necessary visas. Service charge and visa fees will be borne by the passenger. The Company does not guarantee the approval of the visa application. If for any reason, application for visa or exit permit is rejected, a full refund of all monies paid (excluding visa application fees) will be made, if the result of the rejection is made known to the Company at least 30 days prior to departures.

The Company cannot be held responsible for any expenses, reimbursement or refund of any tour fares if passenger is refused entry by any country on the tour for whatever reasons, including lack of necessary visas.

#### SEAT ROTATION

For the convenience of all members of the group, passengers are requested to rotate their seating arrangements on the coach during the period of the tour. Please co-operate when called upon to do so by the tour leader/guide.

#### TRAVEL INSURANCE

Strongly recommended with respect to such areas as trip cancellation, personal baggage, personal accident, injury and illness. Under no circumstance is The Company to be construed as a carrier under contract for safe carriage of the passenger or her/his baggage and belongings. Our staff will be pleased to assist in the enquiries of any travel insurance.

#### **EXTENSION OF STAY / DEVIATION**

Extension of stay / deviation may be permitted at the end of the tour, subject to validity and restrictions of air ticket, seat confirmation and availability of hotel prior to the commencement of tour. It is the passenger's responsibility to hold firm confirmation for their return flight. When extension of stay / deviation cannot be confirmed three weeks prior to the group's departure date, the passenger is deemed to be taking the original tour schedule. In the event that the original arrangement has been changed by The Company during the process, any extra cost will be borne by the passenger.

Extension of stay / deviation will be at the passenger's own expense and transfer to airport will not be provided. Alteration on the routing or date of travel is at the passenger's own risk. No refund will be made to such a person for unused air tickets or for any meals and sightseeing tours or accommodation not used in part or full.

The air ticket issued is a special ticket, restricted to a specific airline only. It is non-negotiable, non-endorsable, non-reissuable, non-refundable and non-reroutable.

#### **OPTIONAL TOURS**

Optional tours are arranged at the customer's request and confirmed with their consent. The Company is only acting as an agent for the service suppliers; and does not accept any responsibility for said optional tour(s).

#### RESPONSIBILITY

The Company acts only as an agent for the transportation companies, hotels and other principals for the tour programmes. They accept no responsibility for injuries, damage, accident, loss, delay, quarantine, theft, customs regulations, strikes, changes in itinerary, deportation or refusal of entry by Immigration Authorities resulting from improper travel documents, possession of unlawful items or irregularities that may be caused to person or property. Any losses or expenses are the responsibility of the passenger. All proper travel documentation is the sole responsibility of the passenger.

The Company reserves the right to alter itineraries, travel arrangements, hotel reservations etc. If it is necessary or in the case of force majeure, The Company reserves the right to cancel any tour prior to the date of departure for any reasons, including insufficient number of participants (minimum 15 paying adults). The Company will recommend an alternative tour, preferably to the same destination or other destinations. Should the passenger decide not to accept the alternatives, all monies paid shall be refunded in full by The Company without further obligations.

The Company also reserves the right to require any individual to withdraw from the tour if deemed his/her act of conduct is detrimental to or incompatible with the interest, harmony and welfare of other passengers and the tour as a whole. Should this right be exercised, all monies paid shall be refunded in full by The Company to the passenger. The Company shall be under no further liability thereafter to any such person.

No tour managers / guides or other employees or agents of The Company are authorized to commit The Company to any liability whatsoever and The Company will not be bound by any statement unless in writing and signed by a management executive of The Company.

The Company reserves the right to take the films and photographs of passengers while on tour with The Company to be used for brochures, advertising or publicity material without obtaining any further consent from the passenger.

It is the prerogative of The Company to cancel the tour in whole or in part if there is a real possibility that the life, limb or property of any person may be endangered. The Company will refund in whole or in part as the case may be, and will not be responsible for any further liability.
